

## **Directions to seminar location:**

### ***From downtown Hendersonville:***

Take 64 West about 1.5 miles. When you see Laurel Park Shopping Center (on right) and an Exxon station on the left, you will need to carefully look for your Right turn **at the stoplight in front of the Exxon**. Turn Right onto Windsor Drive, which is paved. (Don't turn on Davis Circle which is the gravel road just before Windsor - it winds around too much and isn't a good road). Once you turn on Windsor Dr., drive slowly forward about 20 yards - you'll see the other end of **Davis Circle (a gravel road on the right)** and David Goldner's 2-story tan house with covered porch on the corner of Windsor and Davis. Turn Right onto Davis Circle and then left into his driveway.

### ***From Interstate 40 and I-26:***

Around Asheville, you will come to the 1-40 /1-26 / I-240 junction. Take Interstate 26 East toward Hendersonville. Travel about 18 miles. Take Exit 49-B (also labeled as Old Exit I8-B) since there is construction underway and the Exit numbers are being changed). This exit comes out merging into US Hwy. 64 West (also known at this point as Four Seasons Boulevard) a 4-6 lane road heading into Hendersonville. Take-64W straight into town. It will become a one-way road although still 3-4 lanes wide. Stay in the center lane. When you get to Grove St., King St. and then Main Street, the road will be splitting. (Left lane will be 25 South; Center lane is 64 West; Right lane will turn to 25 North). Stay on 64W. After you cross Church Street (after Main Street), **64W turns to the Left in front of Immaculata School**, and then immediately turns to the Right at the first stoplight. Once you turn Right, you'll stay straight on 64 West for about 1.5 miles. When you reach Laurel Park Shopping Center on the right and an Exxon station on the left, you will need to carefully look for your Right turn **at the stoplight in front of the Exxon**. Turn Right onto Windsor Drive, which is paved. (Don't turn on Davis Circle which is the gravel road just before Windsor. It ends up in the same place but winds around too much and isn't a good road.) Once you turn on Windsor Dr., drive slowly forward about 20 yards - you'll see the other end of **Davis Circle** (a gravel road on the right) and David Goldner's 2-story tan house with a covered porch on the corner of Windsor and Davis (the only 2-story house). Turn Right onto Davis Circle and then bear left into his driveway.

### ***From Brevard:***

Take 64 East to Hendersonville. When you reach the stoplight just before Laurel Park Shopping Center, there is an Exxon station on the Right. Turn Left onto Windsor Drive (a paved road) at the light. Once you turn on Windsor Dr., drive slowly forward about 20 yards. You'll see **Davis Circle (a gravel road on the right)** and David Goldner's 2-story tan house with a covered porch on the corner of Windsor and Davis. Turn Right onto Davis Circle and then bear left into his driveway. His is the only 2-story house in this area.
